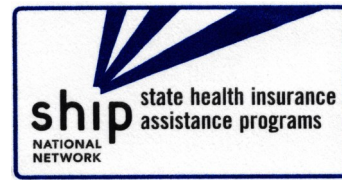

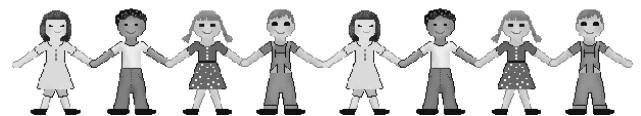

Families must meet income eligibility requirements.

Head Start is a family centered child development program for 3 and 4 year olds. Our comprehensive services provide opportunities that help children to develop school readiness skills and assist families in recognizing their role as their child’s first and most important teacher. Nutritious meals are served daily. Transportation is provided where possible. The Paoli Center offers single session classes.
