The CEO informed the Board that Hoosier Uplands in partnership with the Washington County YMCA has applied for a \$150,000 grant through the Family and Social Services Administration Division of Mental Health and Addiction to support substance abuse and mental health promotion programing. This project will include environmental and evidence based strategies to reduce substance misuse in Washington County. If awarded, the grant will run from November 1, 2021 June 30, 2023. We will serve as the fiscal agent for this project and contract out the majority of the funding to the YMCA.
