

David has served as the CEO of Hoosier Uplands since the spring of 1987




GREAT NEWS TO SHARE:

We're excited to announce that construction has begun on Limestone Edge, a 32-unit senior housing community on Shawnee Dr in Bedford, with 8 units reserved for individuals experiencing homelessness. Opening is anticipated in late spring.

Limestone Edge will offer its residents the unique features of a community room with an art area, telehealth office, on-site resident support services, and more. Residents will also enjoy access to an intergenerational playground with exercise equipment and a pickleball court, creating a connected community for all.

This will bring Hoosier Uplands housing count to 17 properties across 5 counties offering 466 units of safe and affordable housing.
